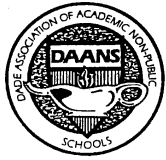

REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTERPOINTS FOR DAANS PROFESSIONAL LEADERSHIP 2008-2009 SERIES

- 1. Pay** for seminar series.

- 3. Sign in** at all five seminars.
- 4. Log 36 independent hours to complete 36 non-contact hour requirement**, choosing a project based on one of the sessions and then implementing the practices taught in the seminar in your school and then completing a written assignment on the implementation of your project. The project is to be **6 pages (double spaced, 12 font)** and is to include why you chose your particular project and how you implemented it in your school, what obstacles you faced and what successes you experienced. **If possible, attach photos, beyond the six pages, to show various aspects of the implementation.**
- 5. Write a one page (double spaced, 12 font) paper** with your analysis/critique of this year's speakers and topics you would care to see in the future.
- 6. Email papers, and photos to daansdirector@gmail.com no later than February 25, 2010, to receive credit for your work via an FCIS certificate for 60 master inservice points.**
